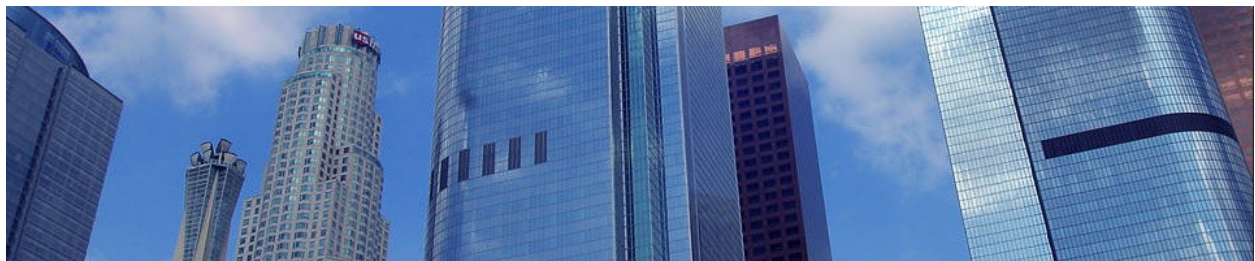

Professor Frederick Nwosu's experiences span across multiple platforms:

He lived through a nasty genocidal war.

He nearly lost his life to mortar and other military ordinances.

He lost his father while in the elementary school.

He saw himself through his first four-year college without financial aid, student loans, or gifts of any sort.

He worked for IBM Corporation in the Research Triangle Park building computers, training new hires in computer hardware, and Planar Technical Support.

He co-produced Shaw University Journal for a brief period while a student at the university.

He survived motor accidents while traveling across the country with his band playing live music.

He composed the anthem for Nigeria's National Youth Service Corps (NYSC) while in the NYSC program.

He composed the anthem for Nigeria's Under-17 Soccer Team captained by Nduka Ugbade that won the World Cup in 1975.

He composed "*Everybody Must Farm*" for Nigeria's Green Revolution called 'Operation Feed the Nation' in 1979-1983.

He supported a family of eight while still a teenager under harsh economic climates.

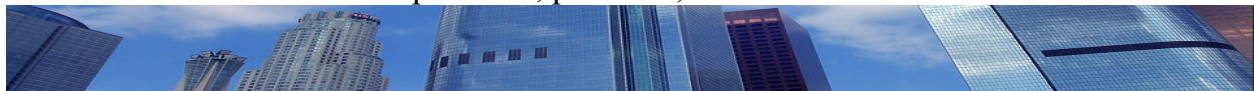
He survived all obstacles and earned two four-year college degrees (Cum Laude and Summa Cum Laude respectively), an MBA, and a PhD with multiple specializations (in Finance, Management, and Leadership).

He is the GPMI Spokesperson on Healthful Living, selected because of his health and looks at his age.

He worked for American Airlines South-East Reservation Office headquarters, and was on duty on the fateful September 11, 2001 when a phone call came to the office from one of the hijacked air planes.

He formed many for-profit and nonprofit organizations in the West as well as in Africa.

He is on over 350 music albums as either keyboard player, composer, vocalist, co-producer, producer, or director.

One of his highlight events was the Commencement Speech at Faith Bible College in 2000.

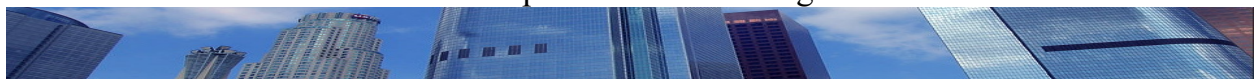
He has driven across the entire East Coast United States and several Central United States cities on his country-side adventures.

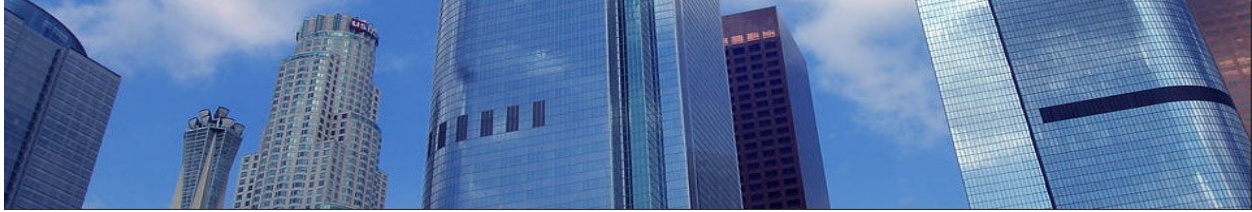
